



Good Guy Award

Description:

An award for either a guy or a gal who assists the Girl Scouts without an official volunteer role. Good Guy nominees should have provided support to a troop or a service unit. This award is presented at the annual GSOC Recognition Event.

Criteria:

Open to nomination by anyone and approved by the Adult Recognition Committee.

Example:

Alan has picked up and transported cookies for his daughter's troop for the past 9 years. He supports his wife who is a troop leader and Service Unit Manager. Alan has set up A/V equipment for the Service Unit's COA event for the past few years as well as driving and picking up different equipment and things needed to run the Service Unit effectively. Alan came to the rescue this past fall during their camp out to assist the troops whose safety was threatened by some baby rattlesnakes. He assisted in keeping the girls and leaders calm and helping to take down camp and ensure the safety of everyone there.
